#### **Good Provider?**

Most of us at Peace Church grew up in an era in which it was believed that men needed to be good providers for their families above almost all else. If a couple fell in love and considered marriage, the woman was often asked if the man she loved would be a good provider. Often men in ages past have felt the pressure to be the sole provider for their families, as women were not expected to work outside the home. In my family, that was the original expectations when my parents married in 1970. My dad would be the bread winner and my mom would stay home and raise my sister and i. Well, that plan didn't exactly work out as my parents aot divorced in about My mom soon had to 1981. become a provider in my family, as well. Many of you may have similar stories.

Then men in my family have been good providers, traditionally, but many of the women have been great providers, as well. My grandfather on my mom's side was a surgeon at Hermann Hospital, so he was a great provider for his family. My grandfather on my dad's side was an inventor, so his income was more sporadic. He might have been the best provider in the family, but he lost the patent on a crucial "C" valve used on almost all gas pumps, so the family story goes. I have tried to be the

best provider I could be for my family, but so has Carrie. Nowadays it's much more difficult for one parent in a family to be the sole provider of all the income a family needs. Most families include two working parents because of the high cost of essentials compared to ages past.



No matter how hard a mother and a father my work to provide for their family, God will always be the ultimate provider. Everything that we have comes from God. As Psalm 24 reminds us, "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it." This means even all that we earn to provide for our families ultimately belongs to God. And God is happy to provide for all our needs. He gave us a planet that was just the right size, just the right distance from the Sun, that contains just the right elements for life, with just the right moon rotating in just the right way, and a giant planet called Jupiter in just the right spot to collect most of the asteroids that could hit the earth and cause mass extinctions. God has so fine-tuned the universe that we are able to live on a planet that flourishes with life and abundance. Sometimes

we forget how good we actually have it because of what God has generously provided for us.

Folks in the Bible were less likely to forget the abundance that comes from the Lord as they were more in touch with the earth and the immediate needs of life. We have insulated ourselves in many ways, and our technical advances can trick us into believing we are the best providers of our needs, rather than God. When that happens, we put ourselves in the place of God. We dishonor God and take him for aranted when we do this.

Over the next several weeks, we will be examining just how God does provide for us in our "Prayers of Provision" sermon series. We'll look at passages of scripture that remind us of how God's people have prayed when they were in need and how God has answered those prayers. Hopefully we will become more aware of just how much we need the Lord on a daily basis and become more arateful for his provision of our daily needs. Begin praying now for God to open vour eves to his abundant blessings of many kinds that are around us every day and let him shift your perspective from grumbling about what you don't have to praising him for what you DO have!


