hen do you think vou have been the most at peace in your life? Have you experienced a period of life that you look back on fondly as particularly peaceful? As I reflect back on the life that God has given me, there are not too many periods of time that I would describe as truly peaceful. I have always felt called to be a very active and hardworking person, maybe even to a fault. Certainly right now in my current phase of life, I know that I am probably working too much with too little peaceful time. I have made it one of my personal spiritual development goals as part of the Discipleship Triad Group I am part of to spend more time at home and less time working. There have been some very peaceful evenings spent with family and friends lately, or moments in my hammock in the backyard on a cool spring evening. God desires to give us all PEACE in this life.

So many times when God would appear to people in the Bible in the form of an angel, or in his direct voice, or through Jesus, or the Holy Spirit, the greeting he would give to his

hearers would be "Peace to you." Jesus said to his disciples that he came to give them peace, and not as the world gives, but real, lasting peace. (John 14:27) He wants us to experience the true peace of God in this life and in the life to come. So how do we go about experiencing this true peace?



I think the first step to finding it is to find rest for our souls. Our souls are the parts of us that are most connected to God, most in touch with the world beyond iust the physical, and the part of us that will endure forever as we trust in God for salvation. We find rest for our souls when we better connect to God and make it a priority to pray, read scripture, work less, rest more, and commune with the Holy Spirit. This is not some experience that we can manufacture by just aoina through some step by step

#### plugging in process, our behaviors and expecting a return of a feeling of peace. We cannot create peace. But we can put ourselves in a better place to receive it as we practice those spiritual disciplines I spoke of earlier. God is constantly wanting to give us peace, but our busy schedules, overthinking, worldy pressures, selfish desires, and even sinfulness aet in the way of receiving that gift of his peace.

In June and July, we will be embarking on a journey of peace through the Be Still My Soul sermon series. We will look at many of the scriptures that discuss having God's peace in our lives and learn the practices of prayer that will bring more of that quietness of our souls to us. Do you need more peace in your life? Then pray. Do you know someone else who needs more peace in their lives? Then pray for THEM! And invite them to come and learn the practice of prayer that lead to peace in this series! Jesus said, 'Peace, be still." - Mark 4:39




